SAFETY ADVICE WHEN IN ROME

This pilgrimage celebrates 10 years of the Pope John Paul II Award. We want you to enjoy yourself when in Rome. This wonderful city has over 2,800's of years of history and sights to appreciate and remember.

PICKPOCKETS

Rome is well policed. But pickpocketing is common, particularly on crowded buses, metro and popular tourist sites.

Reduce your risk of being a victim of a pickpocket by keeping the fact that you're a tourist under wraps - meaning don't become distracted when studying maps, taking pictures, or carrying large amounts of cash and personal belongings.

Each day, take only what you need and leave your personals and extra cash locked up at the hotel and carry only the cash you need in a money belt that's tucked away on your person.

Use a purse or bag with zippers and a secure handle or a money belt if traveling with extra cash and personal documents.

WALKING

Rome is full of ruins and old sites that provide tripping and falling hazards. For this reason, wear comfortable, flat walking shoes.

EMERGENCY NUMBERS

If you need to contact the emergency services, call 112 (police), 118 (ambulance) or 115 (fire).

TRAVEL INSURANCE

Travel insurance is included in your trip. JWT will supply a separate insurance cover form to be completed **ONLY** if the passenger has a pre-existing medical condition.

EU citizens are entitled to free emergency treatment under Italy's public healthcare system if you have a valid European Health Insurance Card (EHIC).
