PART 1: ONLINE ACTIVITY

All participants will take part in the Online Derry Youth Programme.

The LIVE happens each Monday night at 7pm and lasts around 15min. This includes a weekly task which will be sent in to the parish leads using WhatsApp to help support the work of the parish.

Once a month on a Tuesday at 8pm we will meet as a group on ZOOM to check in, touch base on any ongoing work that needs support and have a group discussion on a given subject. All participants in the award are expected to attend these monthly meetings.

JPII Commissioning



Youth Alpha

This is an online programme that will run in Lent its 8 weeks and happens on a Monday Night. The programme explores big questions like in a really interesting way and its a chance to meet other JPII participants from around the diocese.

Children's Online ZOOM

This happens once a month on a Sunday afternoon for 30minutes. Families and children for First Holy Communion join us for a short activity and prayer time. This role involves helping to prepare the resources and deliver.

ADVENT & LENT reflections

During Advent and Lent we will hold either a short time of

prayer in the Chapels or use video depending on the restrictions.

It will involve a practise session and then the real run through.

Steelstown Parish Youth Council

Steelstown has recently started the process of setting up a youth council that will meet once a month, inform the main council and have responsibility for helping the parish to reach out to more people. Could you be available one hour a month on an evening for this? Application forms are available.

Social Media and Communication

This role involves once a month providing some content on a given subject for the parish social media platforms. It will involve one video or a take over on the instagram story for a day during the month.

Monthly Friday Adoration

Adoration is when we sit for a quiet hour in the chapel in the presence of the Host (the Blessed Sacrament) and pray. By having people commit to sit we can create a sacred space for others to come in and pray. During this time its a chance to stop and hand everything to God. You might read a bit of scripture, pray the rosary or even draw an image of Gods love during this time.
