Ministers of Holy Communion are to make their way to their designated sub-chapels. Sub-chapels are located under the large video screens (See map attached).

Volunteers Arrive: 09:30

- Check the list and ID
- Informed what corral each will be serving
- Shown where on a map each serving (no more than 100 metres)

Instructions for Ministers of Holy Communion

- During the Eucharistic Prayer of the Mass – calmly, each minister enters the subchapel and receives a ciborium (and pyx) [at least 2 pyxes per corral, please]

- Each minister goes outside to meet with their umbrella stewards.
- As soon as the Our Father begins, they calmly walk to their designated corral.

- WMOF will have asked people to fold up chairs so as to allow a safe procession to and from Holy Communion.

- If Minister of Holy Communion sense they are running out (unlikely, but just in case) they can of course break hosts in two.

- After distribution, they return to the subchapel, return their ciborium and receive themselves, under both kinds.

- First ministers back can assist with this for everyone.

Subchapel Leaders Info:

Each subchapel (No's 1-14) will have

Trestle tables (4) and 4/5 seats

A palette delivered to it by our WMF logistics team

Each palette will contain plenty of ciboria and hosts (in bags of 150) for your zone (these are being prepared individually)

4 to 6 chalices with altar wine

Corporals, purificators (around 1 purificator to every 4 ciboria)

Trays for stacking ciboria

2 bowls for handwashing, bottled water, antiseptic gels.

Mass text, Priest's stole
